# **CPC ICRS29967 - Tachograph and Vehicle Checks**

## Aims

The intention of this course is to ensure each candidate is aware of and sufficiently knowledgeable in the use and operations of both digital and analogue tachographs. It provides a rounded instruction on vehicle checks and safety inspections. Every driver of a Large Goods Vehicle, who is driving for financial gain (a job!) – must, by law, train for 35 hours (that's 5 days), every 5 years. This course is designed to provide 7 hours of this training towards the 35 hours total required.

# Who Attends

Candidates must hold a current valid Professional Driving Licence.

## **Course Content**

- Introduction to tachographs and the legislation
- Analogue tachographs
- Understanding the various traces comparing them to pictographs
- Important of recording all working time
- Introduction and overview of the Digital Tachograph
- Drivers, company, enforcement and workshop cards what they all do, their limits, purpose and abilities
- The "1 minute rule"
- Introduction to properly conducted daily vehicle checks
- Defect reporting

#### **Course Duration**

This is a 1 day course.

#### **Qualification Obtained**

Seven (7) hours added to the candidates Professional Driver record.
